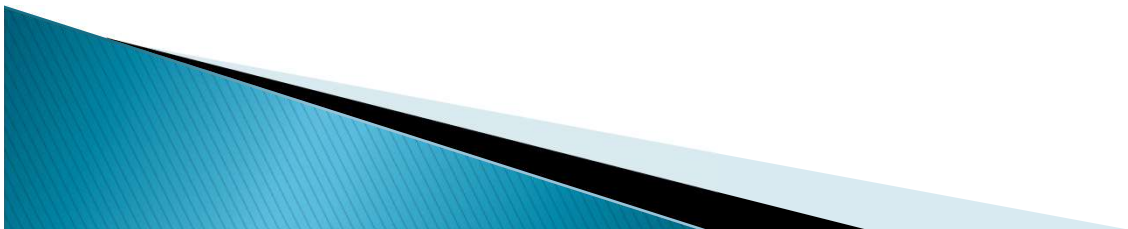

# PK – SUPER WHY:

## MSA West & MSA East

- 8 classes with a paraprofessional each
- Up to 160 students (140 at MSAW/20 at MSAE)
- Curriculum is from LPB (Louisiana Public Broadcasting)
- Open to all students who just completed PK (must be 5 by Sept. 30)
- First come, first serve



# K-2 Literacy Camp:

## MSA West – MSA East

- 8 sections with a paraprofessional each (6 at MSAW/2 at MSAE)
- Up to 160 students (120 at MSAW/40 at MSAE)
- Theme-based curriculum
- Schools will use a universal screener (iREAD) to determine which students would most benefit
- The same universal screener will be used at the end of the camp to measure growth



# 3-8 Academic Enrichment: MSA West – MSA East

- 4 Lead Teachers (3 at MSAW/ 1 at MSAE)
- 24 total teachers (20 at MSAW/ 4 at MSAE)
- Up to 480 students (400 at MSAW / 80 at MSAE)
- Teachers will be content specific (ELA and Math) by grade level and curriculum will include STEM Enrichment
- Schools will identify which students would most benefit based on grades, benchmark assessment data, and a universal screener
- The same universal screener will be used at the end of the program to measure growth

### MSA West – MSA East

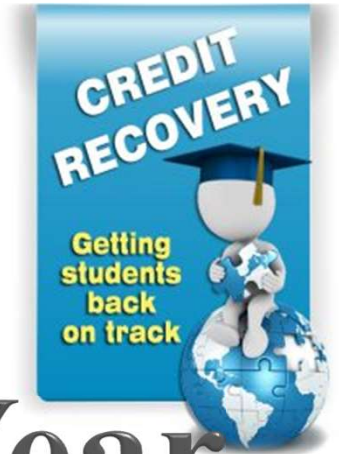
- Instruction Dates: June 5-15
